From the closing cor. of Tps. 32 S., Rs. 8 and 9 W., an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 10° E., 66 lks. dist., marked C C T32S R8W S6 BT. (Old B. T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 10° W., 70 lks. dist., marked CC T32S R9W S1 BT. (Old B. T.)

West, resurveying N. bdy. of sec. 1.

Along S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.45 Trail, Dothan to Eden Valley, bears NW. and SE.

7.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.; ascend.

10.32 Same trail, bears NE. and SW.

11.15 Top of spur, slopes S.; descend.

11.70 Same trail, bears NW. and SE.

18.51 Intersect the cor. of Tps. 31 S., Rs. 8 and 9 W., which is a small mound of stone, witnessed as described by the surveyor general, except for a discrepancy in the record of the bearing trees N. of line and that the NE. tree is dead and fallen. I perpetuate this cor., as follows: at the exact cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 31 S., Rs. 8 and 9 W., with brass cap marked

A laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 51° E., 42 lks. dist., marked T31S R8W S31 BT. (New B. T.)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 26° W., 52 lks. dist., marked T31S R9W S36 BT. (Old B. T.)

Thence S. 87° 10' W., continuing my measurements.

26.25 West Fork of Cow Creek, 75 lks. wide, course SE.; ascend steep rocky slope,

32.00 Ascend over bluffs.

33.00 Top of rocky point, slopes N.; along rocky N. slope.

37.24 (40.00 chs. minus the westing of the E. bdy. of the Tp.)

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, with brass cap marked
