

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 27 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

A cedar, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 37° E., 49 lks. dist., marked S1/16 S2 BT.

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 66½° W., 101 lks. dist., marked S1/16 S3 BT.

Descend 190 ft. over N. slope.

30.89 Left bank of Little River, course W.

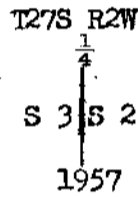
31.69 Right bank of Little River; ascend 106 ft. over S. slope.

33.89 Barbed wire fence, bears E. and W., also telephone line, bears E. and W.

34.14 Graveled and maintained road, 40 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

38.54 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



from which

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 86° E., 55 lks. dist., marked ¼ S2 BT.

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 34° E., 87 lks. dist., marked ¼ S2 BT.

No trees available in sec. 3.

Ascend 1355 ft. over S. slope.

48.90 Abandoned skid road, 20 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

66.05 Abandoned skid road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.

68.03 Maintained dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

77.80 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on N. bdy. of Tp.

Land, mountainous. Soil, stony clay and loam. Timber, fir, cedar, madrone, and maple; undergrowth, salal, poison oak, hazel and Oregon grape.

From the cor. of secs. 9 and 10 only, on the N. bdy. of sec. 16, monumented with a basalt stone, 14x9x8 ins., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked with 3 grooves on the east and 4 grooves on the south face, from which the original bearing trees, as follows:

A sugar pine, 62 ins. diam., bears N. 33° E., 129 lks. dist., with scribe marks T27S R2W S10 BT visible on opened blaze.

A dead hemlock, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 82° E., 118 lks. dist., with opened and rotted blaze, no scribe marks visible.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 52½° W., 126 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A rotted fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 88° W., 45 lks. dist., with no scribe marks visible.
