Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 27 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

From this point, a locally established $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 4, only, bears N. 81° E., $6\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., monumented with a fir post, 2 ins. cross section, 4 ft. above ground.

from which

A cedar, 42 ins. diam., bears N. 25° W., 53 lks. dist., with an opened blaze, no scribe marks visible.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of section 9, as determined from the Red Butte quadrangle sheet of the United States Geological Survey, 1955, is as follows:

Latitude $43^{\circ} 13.7'$ N. Longitude $122^{\circ} 55.8'$ W.

The mean magnetic declination is $20^{\circ} 35'$ E.
