

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 28 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

from which the original bearing trees:

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 30° E., 29 lks. dist., rescribed T28S R4W S11 CS BT. (Record distance 43 lks.)

A cedar, 37 ins. diam., bears S. 40° E., 8 lks. dist., rescribed T28S R4W S14 CS BT.

A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 5° W., 43 lks. dist., rescribed T28S R4W S 15 CS BT.

A madrone, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 88° W., 65 lks. dist., (69 lks. on the slope) rescribed T28S R4W S10 CS BT. (Record distance 69 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which new bearing trees:

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 37½ lks. dist., marked T28S R4W S10 BT.

Deposit local corner material alongside iron post.

N. 88° 54' W., bet. secs. 10 and 15.

Ascend 86 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

3.10 Ridge, bears N. and S., also dirt access road, 20 lks. wide, bears S. 10° E. and N. 10° W. curving to N. 30° W.; descend 136 ft. over SW. slope.

9.45 Ravine, drains S. 10° W.; ascend 11 ft. over SE. slope.

11.30 Spur, slopes S. 10° W.; descend 234 ft. over SW. slope.

18.60 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; ascend 221 ft. over SE. slope.

27.85 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 40° E., ascend 245 ft. over SE. slope.

38.44 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 15, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 13¼° E., 62½ lks. dist., marked ¼ S10 BT.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 38¼° W., 54 lks. dist., marked ¼ S15 BT.

Ascend 92 ft. over SE. slope.

42.25 Dirt access road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

43.20 Top of ascent, slopes S. 20° W.; descend 207 ft. over SW. slope.
