

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 28 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

11.85 Ravine, drains W.; ascend 25 ft. over SW. slope.

14.15 Spur, slopes NW.; descend 48 ft. over NW. slope.

18.85 Spur, slopes NW.; descend 58 ft. over N. slope.

19.75 Point for N. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 37° E., 54 lks. dist., marked N. 1/16 S3 BT.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 30° W., 48 lks. dist., marked N 1/16 S4 BT.

Descend 144 ft. over N. slope.

27.40 Ravine, drains N. 70° W.; descend 24 ft. along W. slope.

33.00 Ravine, drains N. 60° W.; ascend 82 ft. over SW. slope.

38.65 Spur, slopes W.; descend 17 ft. along W. slope.

41.63 The standard cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay and rock out-croppings. Timber, fir, cedar, yew, madrone, myrtle, pine, maple and black oak; undergrowth, hazel, salal, poison oak, wild rose, fern, oceanspray, and chinquapin.

From the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

S. 89° 41' W., bet. secs. 28 and 33.

Descend 131 ft. over W. slope, through logged area and dense undergrowth.

2.61 Abandoned gravel access road, 15 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW., leave logged area and undergrowth, enter cultivated field, edge bears NE. and SW.

5.54 Leave cultivated field, enter logged area with scattering timber and dense undergrowth, edge bears NE. and SW.

6.73 North Myrtle Creek, 20 lks. wide, course S. curving SW.; ascend 174 ft. over E. slope.

12.97 North Myrtle Cree road, bears N. and S., 30 lks. wide.

18.00 Abandoned dirt access road, 12 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.

20.55 Point for E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 33, established and recorded by J. H. Markham, monumented with an iron pipe, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, 2 ins. above ground, from which Markham's bearing trees:

A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 1 1/4° W., 19 lks. dist., with scribe marks 1/16 S BT. visible on bark.

A maple, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 3° W., 15 lks. dist., with scribe marks 1/16 S 2880 BT. on bark.
