Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 28 S., R. 4 W.

## CHAINS

- 3.25 Spur, slopes S.; descend 18 ft. over SW. slope.
- 4.20 Ravine, drains S.; ascend 27 ft. over SE. slope.
- 6.10 Spur, slopes S.; descend 6 ft. over SW. slope.
- 6.90 Ravine, drains S.; ascend 37 ft. over SE. slope changing to S. slope.
- 12.00 Top of ascent, slopes S.; descend 136 ft. over SW. slope.
- 18.40 Ravine, drains S.; ascend 26 ft. over general S. slope.
- 24.55 Top of ascent, slopes S. 30° W.; descend 172 ft. over SW. slope changing to W. slope.

37.47 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, determined at record bearing and distance from the only remaining original bearing tree and substantiated by a rotted and broken-off oak stump which bears N. 40° W., 7 lks. dist. The remaining original bearing tree is as follows:

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 70° E., 14 lks. dist., with faint evidence of an illegible bark scribe.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 ½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 35° 45' E., 33 lks. dist., marked T28S R4W S4 BT.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 46° E., 43 lks. dist., marked T28S R4W S9 BT.

A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 3° W., 119 lks. dist., marked T28S R4W S8 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 19 lks. dist., marked T28S R4W S5 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with thin overlay of humus. Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, madrone, black oak, dogwood and myrtle. Under growth, Oregon grape, vinemaple, fern, hazel, ocean spray, chinquapin, manzanita and mock orange.

From the cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20, and 21.

S. 89° 42' W., bet. secs. 17 and 20.

Ascend 169 ft. over E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 6.70 Spur, slopes S.; descend 66 ft. over W. slope.
- 9.85 Ravine, drains S. 20° W.; ascend 29 ft. over SE. slope.
- 11.25 Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; descend 51 ft. over SW. slope.
- 14.55 Ravine, drains S. 20° W.; ascend 48 ft. over SE. slope.
- 18.15 Spur, slopes S.; descend 86 ft. over SW. slope.
