Dependent Resurvey of Portion of the S. Bdy., T. 25 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 60° E., 16 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 49° W., 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 BT.

Descend 176 ft. over SW. slope, along N. edge of logged area.

49.37 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.; curving to SE.; ascend 593 ft.
over E. slope.

75.80 Ridge and dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.;
descend 74 ft. over W. slope.

77.50 Enter timber, edge bears S. and E.

78.68 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, determined at record bearing and
distance from the only remaining original bearing tree as follows:

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears N. 55° E., 20 lks. dist., with
scribed marks 35 visible on bark blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap marked

An incense cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist.,
marked T26S R4W S2 BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 93 lks. dist., marked
T26S R4W S3 BT.

An incense cedar, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 47 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., 42 lks. dist.,
marked T25S R4W S34 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, clay and loam. Timber, fir, cedar, yew,
oak, madrone, maple that has been logged to the south; undergrowth,
fir reproduction.

From the cor. of Tps. 25 and 26 S., Rs. 3 and 4 W.

N. 0° 10' E., between secs. 31 and 36, marking and blazing true line.

Descend 41 ft. over broken E. slope, through logged area with scat-
tering timber and undergrowth.

10.10 Intermittent creek, 3 lks. wide, course W.; ascend 323 ft. over
SE. slope.

32.90 Spur, slopes E.; descend 102 ft. over NE. slope.

36.90 Dirt logging road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE. curving to S.
