Dependent Resurvey of Portion of the E. Bdy., T. 25 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

- 9.24 Spur, slopes E.; descend 232 ft. over NE. slope.
- 14.87 Abandoned skid road, 20 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.
- 16.27 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 12 ft. over SE. slope.
- 20.56 Spur, slopes E.; descend 181 ft. over NE. slope.
- 27.03 Abandoned skid road, 20 lks. wide, bears E. and W.
- 28.37 Slide Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend 112 ft. over SW. slope.
- 31.77 Maintained dirt access road, 30 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.
- 36.90 Spur, slopes W.; descend 44 ft. over NW. slope.
- 41.56 Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, course W.; ascend 8 ft. over SW. slope.
- 42.39 The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, madrone, dogwood and oak; undergrowth, vinemaple, slal, hazel, willow and salmonberry.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, determined at record bearing and distance the remaining original bearing trees,

A fir snag, 55 ins. diam., bears S. 39° E., 120 lks. dist., with scribe marks 25T & visible on partially opened blaze.

A fir, 70 ins. diam., bears S. 19° W., 27 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 16½° E., 205½ lks. dist., marked T25S R4W S19 BT.

A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 75° E., 201 lks. dist., marked T25S R4W S30 BT.

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears N. 33¼° W., 56 lks. dist., marked T25S R5W S24 BT.

N. 0° 06' W., between secs. 19 and 24, marking and blazing the true line.

Descend 6 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 0.53 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; ascend 15 ft. over SW. slope.
- 4.70 Top of ascent, slopes W.; descend 13 ft. along W. slope.
