

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 25 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous. Soil, stony clay. Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, madrone, and maple; undergrowth, hazel, poison oak, fir reproduction, vinemapple and salal.

N. $0^{\circ} 04'$ E. between secs. 27 and 28.

Ascend 68 ft. over S. slope, through logged area with scattering timber and undergrowth.

3.90 Main divide between Calapocya Creek and North Umpqua River drainage, bears E. and W.; also woven-wire fence bears E. and W.; descend 321 ft. over N. slope changing to NW. slope.

15.72 Foot of descent, slopes W.; ascend 66 ft. over SW. slope.

20.075 Point for the S $1/16$ sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 28.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which

A cedar, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 52° E., 52 lks. dist., marked S $1/16$ S27 BT.

A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S. $64\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 37 lks. dist., marked S $1/16$ S28 BT.

Ascend 3 ft. over SW. slope.

21.30 Top of ascent slopes W.; descend 19 ft. along W. slope.

26.80 Spur, slopes N.; descend 344 ft. over NW. slope changing to N. slope.

27.60 Skid road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.

29.34 Same skid road, 10 lks. wide, bears NE. and S. 30° W.

32.61 Skid road, 10 lks. wide, bears NE. and S. 30° W.

35.95 Skid road, 10 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

40.15 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 28, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A white fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 20° E., 98 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT.

A white fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 89° W., 7 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S28 BT.

Descend 131 ft. over N. slope.

40.30 Skid road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 80° E. and west.
