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| CHAINS 9.62 | Foot of descent, slopes SW.; ascend 88 ft. over SE. slope. |
| 10.30 | Graded dirt logging road, 15 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.; enter logged area, edge bears N. and S. |
| 15.06 | Spur, slopes S. 20° E.; descend 52 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 17.93 | Foot of descent, slopes S.; ascend 8 ft. over SE. slope. |
| 18.88 | Spur, slopes S. 30° W.; descend 10 ft. over W. slope. |
| 20.09 | Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 27. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked <div style="text-align: center;"> $W \frac{1}{16} \frac{S 22}{S 27}$ 1957 </div> from which A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 2½° W., 57 lks. dist., marked W 1/16 S22 BT. A cedar, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 6° W., 27 lks. dist., marked W 1/16 S27 BT. Descend 161 ft. over W. slope. |
| 25.61 | Foot of descent, slopes S.; ascend 25 ft. over SE. slope. |
| 28.58 | Spur, slopes S., also skid road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 10° W. and SE.; descend 127 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 31.70 | Abandoned skid road, 10 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW. |
| 33.48 | Foot of descent, slopes S.; ascend 29 ft. over SE. slope. |
| 36.26 | Spur, slopes S.; descend 47 ft. over SW. slope. |
| 40.18 | The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28. Land, mountainous. Soil, stony clay. Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, oak, maple and madrone; undergrowth, hazel, vinemaple, poison oak, fern, salal, and fir reproduction. |
| | From the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22. N. 0° 04' E., between secs. 15 and 16. Descend 340 ft. over N. slope on spur through scattering timber and light undergrowth. |
| 13.92 | Corner of fences extending N., E., and W. |
| 21.55 | Base of slope bears E. and W.; descend 14 ft. over bottom land, through patches of scrub oak. |
| 28.21 | Dry bed of markham Creek, 8 lks. wide, course N. 40° W., ascend 1 ft. over creek bottom. |
| 29.55 | Dry branch, 4 lks. wide, course W.; ascend 2 ft. over valley bottom. |
| 30.54 | Woven-wire fence, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; enter cultivated field. |
| 37.35 | Woven-wire fence, bears E. and W. |
| 37.55 | Dry branch, 4 lks. wide, course W.; ascend 4 ft. over cultivated field. |
