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Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 25 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

T25S R4W

 $\frac{1}{4} \frac{S}{S} \frac{9}{16}$

from which

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 13° E., 73 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S9 BT.A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $22\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 142 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S16 BT.

Reset the drill bit and fir post alongside the iron post.

S. $88^{\circ} 49'$ W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 103 ft. over E. slope, through logged area.

4.39 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. and S.

6.31 Spur ridge bears NE. and SW.; descend 30 ft. over W. slope.

7.55 Head of ravine, course NW.; descend 110 ft. over NW. slope.

14.12 Ravine, course N.; ascend 47 ft. over NE. slope.

16.62 Top of ascent, slopes N.; descend 15 ft. over NW. slope.

19.775 Point for the W $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 16.Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, with brass cap markedW $\frac{1}{16}$ $\frac{S}{S} \frac{9}{16}$

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N. $60\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 187 lks. dist., marked W $\frac{1}{16}$ S9 BT.A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 63° W., $62\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., marked W $\frac{1}{16}$ S16 BT.

Descend 176 ft. over broken W. slope changing to NW. slope along the N. edge of scattering timber.

29.58 Ravine, drains N.; ascend 48 ft. over NE. slope.

33.00 Top of ascent, slopes N.; descend 57 ft. over NW. slope through thick manzanita and reproduction.

39.55 The corner of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17.

Land, E. half, level valley bottom; W. half, hilly. Soil, E. half, loam; W. half, clay and loam. Timber, scattering fir, maple, white and black oak, ash and madrone. Undergrowth, poison oak, wild roses, blackberry, young fir, manzanita, salal, hazel and thimbleberry.

From the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

N. $88^{\circ} 49'$ W., between secs. 29 and 32.
