Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T 25 S R. 4 W.

CHAINS

Descend 16 ft. over SW. slope through prairie with scattering timber and reproduction.

1.17 Head of ravine, course S. 15° E.; ascend 100 ft. over E. slope.

5.08 Woven-wire fence bears N. and S.

5.21 Main divide between Calapooya Creek and North Umpqua River drainage, bears N. and S.; also dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. and S.; descend 325 ft. over NW. slope.

5.81 Woven-wire fence, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; leave prairie, enter logged area.

13.49 Spring branch, 1 lks. wide, course N.; ascend 9 ft. over NE. slope.

14.50 Enter fir reproduction, edge bears N. and S.

19.445 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 54° E., 40½ lks. dist., marked E 1/16 S29 BT.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 30° 45' E., 61 lks. dist., marked E 1/16 S32 BT.

Ascend 81 ft. over E. slope, leave reproduction, enter logged area.

22.61 Dirt and gravel road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 10° E. and S. 20° W.

25.04 Logging road, 10 lks. wide, spur ridge, bears N. and S.; descend 329 ft. over W. slope changing to SW. slope.

31.54 Abandoned logging road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and SE.

36.18 Three-wire transmission line, bears N. and S.

38.89 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32, determined at record distance from two original bearing trees, as follows:

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N. 39¼° E., 32 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze. (Record bearing N. 35° E.)

A cedar, 31 ins. diam., bears S. 40° E., 23 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked.

Descend 198 ft. over SW. slope, through logged area with scattering timber.
