

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the East Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 7.85 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 80 ft. along W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
- 14.20 Dry branch, 3 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 135 ft. over SW. slope.
- 19.33 The closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, T. 20 S., R. 7 W., monumented with a shattered sandstone, 16 x 12 x 12 ins., loosely set 12 ins. in the ground, from which the remaining original bearing trees:
- A fir snag, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 47° E., 70 lks. dist., with marks BT 7W visible on remaining portion of bark blaze.
- A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W., 43 lks. dist., with no marks visible on open blaze. (Record distance, 48 lks.)
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 50½° E., 52 lks. dist., marked T20S R7W S19 CC BT.
- A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 17° E., 44 lks. dist., marked T20S R7W S30 CC BT.
- Ascend 34 ft. over SW. slope.
- 21.67 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.
- 25.11 Draw, drains W.; desc. 223 ft. along broken W. slope.
- 37.25 Dry branch, 3 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 69 ft. over SW. slope.
- 40.25 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 24, determined at record bearing and distance from the original bearing trees:
- A cedar, 37 ins. diam., bears N. 62° E., 24 lks. dist., with marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT uncovered.
- A cedar, 21 ins. diam., bears S. 53° W., 12 lks. dist., with portions of scribe marks uncovered.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 62 ins. diam., bears N. 7° W., 74 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S24 BT.
- The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. falls on top of ascent on W. slope.
