

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the East Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

N. 1° 17' E., beginning new measurement.

Descend 65 ft. along W. slope.

- 5.67 Wet ravine, drains N. 70° W.; desc. 68 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
- 11.44 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.; asc. 188 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
- 19.02 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 24 ft. over NW. slope.
- 21.09 Ravine, drains S. 30° W.; asc. 252 ft. over S. slope, changing to W. slope.
- 29.87 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 208 ft. over NW. slope.
- 36.07 Ravine, drains W.; asc. 67 ft. over SW. slope.
- 37.96 Spur, slopes S. 50° W.; asc. 16 ft. along W. slope.
- 39.51 The cor. of secs. 13 and 24, located on blazed line, at record bearing from the remaining original bearing trees:

A maple, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 62° E., 39 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze. (Record distance 41 lks.)

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 31 lks. dist., with no marks visible on opened blaze. (Record distance 33 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which a new bearing tree

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 38 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W., 65 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S13 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

N. 1° 05' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 13.

Ascend 5 ft. along W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 0.68 Ravine, drains SW.; asc. 285 ft. over S. slope.
- 6.96 Flat spur, slopes W.; desc. 425 ft. over N. slope.
- 17.42 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 70° W.; asc. 12 ft. over SW. slope.
- 17.88 The closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, T. 20 S., R. 7 W., determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree:

A turned out fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 79° E., 39 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.
