

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the West Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. $41\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 31 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S18 BT.

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S. $30\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 5 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S18 BT.

The corner falls on a spur sloping S. 70° W.

N. $0^{\circ} 08'$ E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 42 ft. along broken W. slope.

12.00 Ravine, drains S. 70° W.; asc. 279 ft. over S. slope.

18.40 Flat spur, slopes S. 65° W.; asc. 10 ft. along SW. slope.

19.38 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 16 ft. along W. slope.

21.96 Bottom of descent on W. slope; asc. 38 ft. along W. slope.

24.35 Ridge, bears S. 30° E. and N. 30° W.; desc. 178 ft. along E. slope.

34.30 Spur, slopes N. 60° E.; desc. 205 ft. over N. slope.

37.48 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 13, T. 20 S., R. 9 W., at midpoint on the E. bdy. of sec. 13.

37.95 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 91 ft. over SE. slope.

39.85 The cor. of secs. 7 and 18, determined at record bearings and distances from the original bearing trees:

A shattered hemlock stump, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 68° E., 5 lks. dist., marked with portions of scribe marks.

A dogwood, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 63° E., 30 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.

A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 46° W., 5 lks. dist., with marks T20S R9W S13 uncovered.

A maple, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 65° W., 36 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 84° E., 49 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S7 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

N. $0^{\circ} 34'$ E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 7.
