Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the West Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- Ascend 173 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 6.12 Spur ridge, bears N. 50° E. and S. 50° W.; desc. 327 ft. over NW. slope.
- 14.44 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 70° E.; asc. 411 ft. over SE. slope.
- 30.40 Ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 144 ft. over NE. slope, changing to NW. slope.
- 36.47 Point for the closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 20 S., R. 9 W., at proportionate distance, on spur, slopes NW.; desc. 91 ft. over N. slope.
- 38.14 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 7, determined at record bearing and distance from the original NW. bearing tree, and at record distance from a tree which does not agree with the record:
- A cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 78° E., 36 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze. (Record, a maple, bears N. 72° E.)
- A maple, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W., 20 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- from which a new bearing tree
- A cedar, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 51° E., 90 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT.
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- N. 0° 37' E., beginning new measurement.
- Descend 172 ft. over N. slope.
- 3.15 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 425 ft. over SW. slope, changing to S. slope.
- 13.00 Spur, slopes S. 10° E.; asc. 45 ft. along E. slope.
- 15.25 Head of ravine, drains SE.; asc. 98 ft. over S. slope.
- 17.23 Ridge, bears N. 75° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 135 ft. over N. slope.
- 21.25 Ravine, drains N. 10° W.; desc. 157 ft. along W. slope.
- 26.95 Ravine, drains N. 30° E.; desc. 12 ft. along E. slope.
- 29.22 Bottom of descent on E. slope; asc. 102 ft. over SE. slope.
- 33.24 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 58 ft. over NE. slope.
- 35.14 Head of ravine, drains E.; asc. 210 ft. over SE. slope.
- 38.735 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 12, T. 20 S., R. 9 W., at proportionate distance.
