Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the North Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

## CHAINS

- 4.20 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 414 ft. over SE. slope.
- 13.80 Ridge, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.; desc. 411 ft. over W. slope.
- 25.80 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 280 ft. over E. slope.
- 32.40 Spur ridge, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.; desc. 27 ft. along N. slope.
- 34.80 Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 202 ft. over E. slope.
- 39.58 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing trees:
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 36½° E., 43 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.
- A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 14¾° W., 34 lks. dist., with marks T20S R8W S6 uncovered.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 12° E., 70 lks. dist., marked T19S R8W S32 BT.
- A fir, 33 ins. diam., bears S. 33¼° E., 81 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S5 BT.
- A fir, 53 ins. diam., bears S. 18¼° W., 43 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S6 BT.
- A fir, 70 ins. diam., bears N. 50½° W., 63 lks. dist., marked T19S R8W S31 BT.
- Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

- N. 88° 54' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.
- Ascend 62 ft. over E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 1.95 Ridge, bears NE. and S. 70° W.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
- 5.20 Ridge at saddle, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.; asc. 155 ft. over SE. slope.
- 14.70 Ridge, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.; asc. 68 ft. over NE. slope.
- 20.60 Spur, slopes N. 10° E.; desc. 73 ft. over NW. slope.
- 25.60 Head of ravine, drains N. 10° E.; asc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.
