CHAINS 29.00	Ridge dividing N. Sister Creek and Smith River, bears N. and S. 5° E.; desc. 416 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
38.00	Dry branch, 6 lks. wide, course N. 5° W.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.

0.37	Branch, 3 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 318 ft. over S. slope.
7.37	Spur, slopes S. 60° W.; desc. 207 ft. over NW. slope.
16.41	Draw, drains S. 80° W.; asc. 458 ft. over SE. slope.
33.25	Spur ridge, bears N. 85° E. and S. 50° W.; desc. 250 ft. over N. slope.
