

## Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

## CHAINS

Descend 113 ft. over broken NW. slope.

55.95 Draw, drains S. 35° W.; asc. 93 ft. over SW. slope.

58.59 Spur, slopes S. 60° W.; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.

62.50 Bottom of descent on W. slope; asc. 162 ft. over SW. slope.

69.42 Ridge, bears E. and N. 60° W.; desc. 159 ft. over N. slope.

73.68 Draw, drains N. 80° E.; asc. 76 ft. over SE. slope.

76.31 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24.

N. 88° 23' W., bet. secs. 14 and 23.

Ascend 346 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

8.36 Ridge, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; desc. 494 ft. over NW. slope.

23.07 Dry creek bed, 45 lks. wide, course N. 10° E.; asc. 377 ft. over SE. slope.

39.37 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 23, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 37° E., 97 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S14 BT.

A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S. 16° E., 95 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S23 BT.

Ascend 186 ft. over SE. slope.

43.47 Ridge, bears N. 85° E. and S. 50° W.; desc. 718 ft. over broken SW. slope.

73.14 South Sister Creek, 30 lks. wide, course S. 40° W.; asc. 14 ft. over SE. slope.

75.99 Unimproved road, 15 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 13 ft. over SE. slope.

78.74 The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
