

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 30° E., 47 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S15 BT.

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 28½° W., 34 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S16 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14, and 15.

N. 88°06' W., bet. secs. 10 and 15.

Descend 292 ft. over SW. slope.

6.65 Dry branch, 6 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; asc. 254 ft. over broken E. slope.

18.20 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 394 ft. over NW. slope.

39.745 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 15, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A cedar, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 57° E., 36 lks. dist., marked ¼ S10 BT.

A cedar, 55 ins. diam., bears S. 22° W., 71 lks. dist., marked ¼ S15 BT.

Descend 4 ft. over NW. slope.

40.10 North Sister Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 30° W.; asc. 172 ft. over broken SE. slope.

60.85 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 119 ft. over W. slope.

65.65 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 337 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.

79.49 The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

N. 0° 10' W., bet. secs. 9 and 10.

Ascend 228 ft. over S. slope, changing to SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

8.65 Spur ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 241 ft. over NE. slope.

15.80 Ravine, drains S. 80° E.; asc. 267 ft. over SE. slope.
