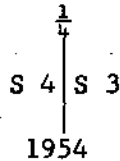


## Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS  
37.56

Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



from which

A fir, 37 ins. diam., bears S.  $66\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E., 22 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S3 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $28\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 14 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S4 BT.

Ascend 298 ft. over SE. slope, changing to SW. slope.

63.80 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 206 ft. over NW. slope.

75.02 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

N.  $0^{\circ} 17'$  W., bet. secs. 20 and 21.

Descend 317 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

6.90 Ravine, drains N.  $50^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 125 ft. along broken W. slope.

15.55 Spur ridge, bears N.  $10^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $10^{\circ}$  W.; desc. 32 ft. over NW. slope.

18.60 Ravine, drains S.  $75^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 55 ft. over SW. slope.

22.45 Ridge, bears N.  $70^{\circ}$  W. and S.  $70^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 383 ft. over NW. slope.

39.09 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 21, determined from the original bearing trees:

A fir, 63 ins. diam., bears N.  $60^{\circ}$  E., 9 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze. (Record bearing, N.  $60^{\circ}$  W.)

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.  $51^{\circ}$  W., 30 lks. dist., marked with a healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
