38.10	Spur, slopes S.; desc. 23 ft. over SW. slope.
39.40	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.
	N. 2° 59' E., bet. secs. 4 and 5. Ascend 81 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
1.70	Ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 209 ft. over N. slope.
7.25	Head of ravine, drains E.; asc. 140 ft. over SE. slope.
12.45	Ridge, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.; desc. 192 ft. over NW. slope.
