

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

cedar, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrona, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, slickleaf, arrowwood, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20.

N. 0° 05' E., bet. secs. 17 and 18.

Descend 55 ft. along E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.50 Bottom of descent on E. slope; asc. 75 ft. over SE. slope.

2.76 Spur ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 362 ft. over NE. slope.

14.48 Smith River, 180 lks. wide, course N. 58° W.; asc. 17 ft. along gentle W. slope.

39.90 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 53° E., 42 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S17 BT.A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 73 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., 11 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S18 BT.

Descend 12 ft. along gentle W. slope.

40.40 Unimproved road, bears N. 5° W. and S. 40° E.

47.95 South Sister Creek, 90 lks. wide, course W. curving to SW.; asc. 125 ft. over SW. slope.

52.33 Blazed trail along spur ridge, bears N. 80° E. and W.; desc. 109 ft. along W. slope.

58.75 North Sister Creek, 45 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 124 ft. along E. slope.

65.00 Truck trail, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.

79.80 Point for the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

from which

A cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 85 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S8 BT.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 4° E., 50 lks. dist., marked T20S R8W S17 BT.
