Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $51^\circ$  E., 121 lks. dist., mkd. T27S R3W S18 BT.

A maple, 15 ins. diam., bears S.  $74\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  E., 86 lks. dist., mkd. T27S R3W S19 BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.  $32^\circ$  W., 48 lks. dist., mkd. T27S R4W S24 BT.

Deposit orig. cor. stone alongside iron post.

From this point the closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24, on the E. bdy. of T. 27 S., R. 4 W., bears N.  $3^\circ 30'$  E., 140 lks. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, 20 ins. above ground, with brass cap marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

N.  $1^\circ 27'$  E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 18, marking and blazing true line.

Descend 275 ft. over NW. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

10.95 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 18 ft. over SW. slope.

13.65 Dirt access road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.

20.08 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 18 only.

Ascend 51 ft. over SW. slope.

22.25 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 331 ft. over NE. slope.

23.10 Graveled and maintained access road, 25 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.

24.35 Skid road, 15 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

40.16 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 18 only, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
