Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the N. Bdy., T. 27 S., R. 3 W.

E 1/16 $\frac{S\ 34}{S\ 3}$
1958

from which

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $44\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 112 lks. dist.,
mkd. E 1/16 S34 BT.

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $73\frac{3}{4}^\circ$ W., 151 lks. dist.,
mkd. E 1/16 S3 BT.

Ascend 64 ft. over NE. slope.

23.54 Leave partially logged area, enter heavy timber, edge bears N. and S.

27.85 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 48 ft. over NW. slope.

31.15 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 173 ft. over NE. slope.

39.05 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34, monumented with a wooden post, 3 x 3 ins. cross section, firmly set, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground, and in a mound of stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 6 ins. high, at record bearing and distance from the only remaining original bearing tree:

A down and rotted pine, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 5° W.,
52 lks. dist., with scribe marks S BT visible on opened
blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground,
and in a mound of stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 13 ins. diam., bears N. $50\frac{3}{4}^\circ$ W., 70 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $38\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 40 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 BT.

Deposit the wood post alongside the iron post.

N. $89^\circ 45'$ W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 13 ft. over broken NE. slope, through heavy timber and
scattering undergrowth.

2.80 Graveled access road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.

7.90 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 72 ft. over NW. slope.

12.50 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NE.; 229 ft. over NE. slope changing to
SE. slope.

19.84 Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.
