

Dependent Resurvey of the South Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

- A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S. $33\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 115 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Record, 116 lks. dist.)
- A fir, 72 ins. diam., bears S. $33\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 182 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Thiel record, 186 lks. dist.; Gesner record, 188 lks. dist.)
- A cedar stump, 56 ins. diam., bears N. $49^{\circ} 45'$ W., 124 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Record, 122 lks. dist.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, and in a small mound of stone, to top, with brass cap marked

from which new bearing trees,

- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $41^{\circ} 45'$ E., 95 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S33 BT.
- A hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 29° W., 122 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S32 BT.

Reset the sandstone alongside the iron post.

From this point a maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 39° W., 33 lks. dist., with partially healed blazes on N., S., E., and W. sides.

Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmon-berry, hazel, arrowwood, evergreen huckleberry, manzanita, ceanothus, salal, and bracken.

S. $89^{\circ} 15'$ E., along the S. bdy. of sec. 33.

Ascend 220 ft. over SW. slope, changing to steep NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 4.25 Spur, slopes S. 5° W.; desc. 265 ft. over broken SE. slope.
- 12.60 Ravine, course S. 10° E.; asc. 85 ft. over SW. slope.
- 15.60 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.
- 17.10 Ravine, course S. 35° W.; asc. 55 ft. over SW. slope.
- 18.70 Point of spur, slopes S. 30° W.; desc. 30 ft. along S. slope.
- 21.30 Ravine, course S. 40° W.; asc. 250 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 30.00 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 5 ft. along S. slope.
- 33.00 Small ravine, course SW.; asc. 320 ft. over steep W. slope.
- 38.80 Ridge, the divide bet. Buck Creek and Vincent Creek, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.; desc. 180 ft. over NE. slope.
- 44.00 Foot of descent on N. slope; asc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
- 46.30 Spur ridge, bears NE. and S. 60° W.; desc. 105 ft. over steep SE. slope.
