

Dependent Resurvey of the South Boundary of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

 $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34
1953

from which new bearing trees,

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. $49\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 50 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears N. $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 52 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.S. $89^{\circ} 59'$ E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 34 ft. along gentle S. slope of flat.

- 4.87 Ridge, the divide bet. Vincent Creek and Scare Creek, bears N. 70° W and S. 50° E.; asc. 24 ft. along broken N. slope.
- 9.85 Same ridge, bears S. 60° E. and SW.; a spur slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 36 ft. along broken N. slope.
- 14.85 Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. 82 ft. along broken N. slope.
- 23.45 Spur, slopes N. 75° E.; desc. 312 ft. over E. slope.
- 31.35 Edge of bench, bears N. and S.; desc. 36 ft. over gentle E. slope of bench.
- 36.50 Edge of bench, bears N. and S.; desc. 214 ft. over NE. slope, changing to E. slope.
- 40.96 The cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, marked by a fir, 38 ins. diam., bearing healed blazes on N., S., E., and W. sides, and scribed in the bark T20 S35 on NE. and R9W S3 on SE. sides, from which the remaining original bearing trees,
- A double maple, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 18° E., 36 lks. dist., with blaze rotted. (Record, bears S. 28° E., 33 lks. dist.)
- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. $25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 42 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Thiel record, 41 lks. dist.; Gesner record, 40 lks. dist.)
- A fir, 70 ins. diam., bears S. 88° W., 75 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S34 BT on bark blaze. (Thiel record, bears N. 88° W., 78 lks. dist.; Gesner record, bears N. 22° W., 75 lks. dist.)
- and new bearing trees,
- A cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 44° E., 65 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S35 BT.
- A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 11° W., 39 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S34 BT.
- Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin, and madrona. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, rhododendron, hazel, arrowwood, ceanothus, manzanita, evergreen huckleberry, poison oak, and salal.

N. $89^{\circ} 33'$ E., along the S. bdy. of sec. 35.

Descend 90 ft. over E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
