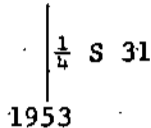


Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the W. Bdy. of T. 19 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 34 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



from which new bearing trees,

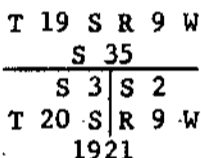
A dogwood, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 9° E., 26 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 37° E., 96 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, hazel, arrowwood, evergreen huckleberry, red huckleberry, rhododendron, and salal.

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the N. Bdy. of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.  
(Restoring the 1891 survey by William Thiel, and the 1899 resurvey by Henry L. Chandler)

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 2 and 3, on the S. bdy. of sec. 35, T. 19 S., R. 9 W., which was remonumented by Fred Mensch, in 1921, with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap marked



from which

A cedar, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 54 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S2 BT. (New bearing tree.)

A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 11 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Thiel bearing tree.)

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 81° W., 52 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S2 BT on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree.)

From this point the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 19 S., R. 9 W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 3, bears West, 0.78 chs. dist., remonumented by Fred Mensch, in 1921, with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

S. 88° 46' E., along the N. bdy. of sec. 2, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 160 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 5.70 Spur ridge, bears N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.; desc. 210 ft. over E. slope.
- 9.65 Head of ravine, course SE.; desc. 190 ft. along S. slope, changing to SE. slope.
- 17.15 Wet ravine, course S. 15° E.; desc. 45 ft. along broken S. slope.
- 24.55 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.; desc. 5 ft. along broken S. slope.
