

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS	
	N. 2° 05' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36, marking and blazing the true line.
	Ascend 80 ft. over gradual SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
15.95	Ridge, the divide bet. Scare Creek and Smith River, bears N. 80° E. and W.; desc. 270 ft. over broken NW. slope.
31.10	Sharply defined spur, slopes N. 5° W.; desc. slightly along E. side of spur.
32.45	Same spur, at junction of spurs, slope N. 30° W. and NE.; desc. 450 ft. over N. slope, changing to NE. slope.
42.00	Dry bed of stream, 4 lks. wide; course NW.; asc. slightly.
42.03	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone; 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

	A hemlock, 31 ins. diam., bears N. 70° E., 111 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT.
	A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 75° W., 58 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.
	Ascend 90 ft. over SW. slope.
47.50	Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 245 ft. along W. slope, broken by small ravines and spurs.
68.80	Branch, 3 lks. wide, in bed, 6 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 200 ft. over SE. slope.
74.40	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 10 ft. over N. slope.
74.85	Ravine, course N. 80° E.; asc. 90 ft. over broken SE. slope.
80.80	Ravine, course SE.; asc. 100 ft. over S. slope.
84.06	The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36, determined from the original accessories, as follows:
	A fir snag, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 46° E., 112 lks. dist., with no marks remaining on burned blaze.
	A rotted fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 69° E., 17 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.
	A fir snag, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 20° W., 69 lks. dist., with no marks remaining on burned blaze.
	A rotted fir stump, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 68° W., 17 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.
	A small mound of stone is found to W. of corner point
	At the corner point
