

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

A cedar, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 77° W., 71 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R9W S14 on unhealed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap marked

A cedar, 60 ins. diam., bears S. $56\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 64 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R9W S24 BT.

A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 71 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R9W S23 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam. Timber, fir,
hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmon-
berry, hazel, arrowwood, evergreen huckleberry, red huckleberry,
and salal.

S. $89^{\circ} 31'$ E., bet. secs. 13 and 24.

Descend 50 ft. over NE. slope, along right bank of intermittent
branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 87° E., through heavy timber and
dense undergrowth.

- 6.70 Intermittent branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 80° E.; asc. 10 ft.
along S. slope.
- 9.20 Point of spur, slopes SE.; desc. 65 ft. over E. slope.
- 12.50 Coldwater Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 600 ft. over broken
SW. slope.
- 32.90 Ridge, bears N. 25° W. and S. 25° E.; desc. 290 ft. over SE. slope.
- 38.50 Ravine, course N. 60° E.; desc. 15 ft. along N. slope.
- 39.51 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, at proportionate
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap marked

- A fir, 67 ins. diam., bears N. 34° E., 31 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S13 BT.
- A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears S. $39\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 83 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S24 BT.
- Descend 110 ft. along N. slope, changing to NE. slope.
- 43.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc. 120 ft. over NW. slope.
- 47.60 Spur, slopes N. 35° E.; desc. 240 ft. over NE. slope.
- 52.25 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 325 ft. over bluffy W. slope.
- 58.10 Spur ridge, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.; desc. 290 ft. over SE.
slope.
