Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

- 23.40 Dry bed of stream, 10 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 360 ft. over SE. slope.
- 31.60 Spur ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 310 ft. over N. slope.
- 37.00 Dry bed of stream, 4 lks. wide, course N. 60° W.; asc. 15 ft. over SW. slope.
- 38.09 The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14, determined from the remaining original bearing trees, as follows:
- A sawed fir stump, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 43½° E., 26 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S12 BT on bark blaze.
- A fir snag, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 5° W., 140 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S14 BT on bark blaze.
- A sawed fir stump, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 3½° W., 55 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 33½° E., 74 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S12 BT.
- A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 54½° E., 19 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S13 BT.
- An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 11° 45' W., 51 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S14 BT.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 29¼° W., 31 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S11 BT.
- Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, yew, and dogwood. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, rhododendron, red huckleberry, ceanothus, arrowwood, and salal.

- S. 89° 46' E., bet. secs. 12 and 13.
- Ascend 225 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 4.38 Spur ridge, bears N. 5° E. and S. 5° W.; desc. 200 ft. over E. slope.
- 8.03 Ravine, course N. 20° E.; asc. 125 ft. over NW. slope.
- 12.04 Spur, slopes N. 5° W.; desc. 190 ft. over NE. slope.
- 16.70 Dry bed of stream, 3 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc. 370 ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
- 24.55 Spur ridge, bears NW. and S. 10° W.; spur slopes NE.; desc. 395 ft. over SE. slope.
- 35.80 Ravine, course N. 60° E.; desc. slightly along N. slope.
