

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 47° W., 34 lks. dist.,  
marked T20S R9W S11 BT on bark blaze.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 29° W., 4 lks. dist.,  
marked T20S R9W S2 BT on bark blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,  
with brass cap marked

S 11 | S 12

from which new bearing trees

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 71½° E., 59 lks. dist.,  
marked T20S R9W S1 BT.

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 58½° E., 43 lks. dist.,  
marked T20S R9W S12 BT.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 5½° W., 56 lks. dist.,  
marked T20S R9W S11 BT.

Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir,  
hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel,  
arrowwood, evergreen huckleberry, slamonberry, rhododendron, and  
salal.

East, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Ascend 10 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-  
growth.

- 1.40 Flat spur, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 169 ft. over SE. slope.
- 6.50 Enter bottom land; edge bears N. and S.; desc. 11 ft. across bottom.
- 6.85 Preliminary center line of access road under construction, bears  
N. 25° E. and S. 25° W.
- 9.10 West Fork of Smith River, 50 lks. wide, course S. 15° W.; asc. 16  
ft. across bottom.
- 12.00 Leave bottom land; edge bears N. 15° E. and S. 15° W.; asc. 47 ft.  
over NW. slope.
- 14.30 Spur, slopes S. 30° W.; desc. 59 ft. over SE. slope.
- 16.10 Enter bottom land; edge bears NE. and SW.; desc. 14 ft. across  
bottom.
- 18.75 West Fork of Smith River, 65 lks. wide, course N. 40° E.; desc.  
slightly across bottom.
- 19.70 Telephone line, bears N. and S.
- 23.40 Truck trail, bears N. 22° W. and S. 13° E. on curve.
- 23.80 West Fork of Smith River, 40 lks. wide, course S. 13° E.; asc. 125  
ft. over W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
- 27.50 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 26 ft. along broken S. slope.
- 29.85 Spring, on line, 5 lks. wide, drains S.; desc. 39 ft. along S.  
slope.
- 37.75 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course S. 5° W.; asc. 70 ft. over W. slope.
