

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, and yew. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, hazel, arrowwood, rhododendron, and salal.
	From the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.
	N. 88° 47' W., bet. secs. 14 and 23.
	Descend 4 ft. along N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
0.65	Enter intermittent branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 66° E.; asc. 5 ft. along branch.
2.00	Leave branch, course S. 88° 47' E., from S. 80° W.; asc. 37 ft. along S. slope, near N. side of branch.
3.34	A cedar, 58 ins. diam., on line, marked with two healed blazes each on E. and W. sides.
5.00	Same branch, 3 lks. wide, course S. 85° E., at forks, each 2 lks. wide, from NW. and S. 50° W.; asc. 510 ft. over broken E. slope.
17.30	Ridge, the divide bet. Coldwater Creek and Clearwater Creek, bears N. 30° W. and S.; desc. 150 ft. over SW. slope.
21.50	Ravine, course S. 30° W.; desc. 90 ft. along S. slope.
27.00	Hollow, drains S.; asc. 75 ft. along broken S. slope.
30.80	Ravine, course SE.; asc. 155 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
36.50	Ridge, the divide bet. Smith River and West Fork of Smith River, bears N. 30° E. and SW.; desc. 97 ft. over NW. slope.
39.39	The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 23, marked by a cedar, 11 ins. diam., with scribe marks 1/4 S visible on partly healed blaze on N. side, from which the original bearing trees:
	A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 44° W., 25 lks. dist., marked BT on badly scaled bark blaze.
	A cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 65° E., 9 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed.
	and a new bearing tree,
	A fir, 72 ins. diam., bears N. 74° W., 20 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S14 BT.
	S. 85° 40' W., beginning new measurement.
	Descend 25 ft. over NW. slope.
2.30	Head of ravine, course N. 15° E.; asc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.
4.45	Spur, slopes N., at point 25 lks. N. of dividing ridge; desc. 15 ft. along N. slope.
6.00	Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 270 ft. over W. slope.
11.70	Ravine, course N. 30° W.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.
14.40	Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 115 ft. over NW. slope.
16.35	Ravine, course N. 20° E.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.
