

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

- 18.35 Spur, slopes N. 10° W.; desc. 130 ft. over NW. slope.
- 21.85 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 20° W.; at junction with ravine from SW.; asc. 225 ft. over E. slope.
- 26.50 Spur, slopes N. 5° W.; desc. 110 ft. over NW. slope.
- 29.30 Ravine, course N. 40° W.; asc. 20 ft. along N. slope.
- 31.70 Spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 125 ft. over W. slope.
- 34.80 Ravine, course N. 30° W.; on bend to N.; asc. 175 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 37.80 Spur, slopes N. 50° E.; asc. 40 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 40.51 The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

Land, extremely mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder and yew. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, rhododendron, arrowwood, ceanothus, manzanita, thimbleberry, salal, Oregon grape, red huckleberry, and sword fern.

N. 1° 24' E., bet. secs. 14 and 15.

Descend 30 ft. along broken E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 5.00 Ravine, course S. 70° E.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.
- 7.25 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 80 ft. over NE. slope.
- 9.25 Ravine, course N. 50° E.; asc. 95 ft. over SE. slope.
- 13.50 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 160 ft. over NE. slope.
- 20.10 Head of ravine, course E.; asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.
- 22.30 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 40 ft. over NE. slope.
- 26.40 Ridge, bears N. 15° E. and S. 15° W.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope, changing to W. slope.
- 28.80 Same ridge, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; desc. 200 ft. over NE. slope.
- 34.30 Ravine, course N. 50° E.; thence along broken E. slope.
- 38.60 Spur, slopes N. 40° E.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.73 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 15, determined at record bearing and distance from each of the original bearing trees, as follows:

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 47° E., 29 lks. dist., with no marks remaining on scaled bark blaze.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 18 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT on bark blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked
