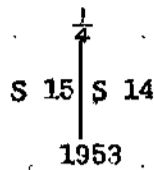


Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

from which new bearing trees,

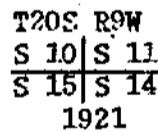
A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 56 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S14 BT.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 57 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

N. 0° 28' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 315 ft. over NW. slope.

- 6.05 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course W.; thence along bench, slopes W.
- 17.60 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 35° W.; asc. 65 ft. over gradual SW. slope.
- 23.30 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 15 ft. over NW. slope.
- 24.80 Top of sandstone bluff, bears NE. and SW.; desc. over NW. slope of bluff, 60 ft.
- 26.00 Left bank of West Fork of Smith River, course SW.
- 26.90 Right bank of West Fork of Smith River, asc. slightly along bottom.
- 31.50 Truck trail, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.
- 33.60 Right bank of West Fork of Smith River, course SE.
- 34.10 Left bank of West Fork of Smith River; truck trail bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; asc. 15 ft. over gentle SW. slope.
- 40.44 The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, remonumented by Fred Mensch, in 1921, with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap marked



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from which

A fir, 65 ins. diam., bears N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 62 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree.)

A fir, 53 ins. diam., bears S. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 86 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S14 BT on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree.)

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 13 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Mensch bearing tree.)

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 30 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Mensch bearing tree, record bearing, N. 28° W. I open blaze sufficiently to uncover partial marks.)

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 64 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S10 BT. (New bearing tree.)

Land, mountainous, with narrow strip of bottom along West Fork. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, rhododendron, and salal.
