

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

- CHAINS
 18.40 Leave spur, slopes E. from S. 60° W.; asc. 75 ft. along N. slope.
 26.00 Top of ascent on N. slope; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
 27.75 Ravine, course N. 40° E.; asc. 230 ft. over E. slope.
 32.70 Spur ridge, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; desc. 30 ft. along broken S. slope.
 38.94 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, rhododendron, evergreen huckleberry, red huckleberry, hazel, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 0° 18' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Descend 26 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

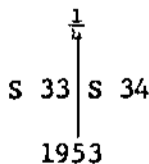
- 1.75 Intermittent branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.; asc. 245 ft. over broken S. slope.
 8.35 Spur, slopes SW.; asc. 65 ft. along W. slope.
 15.40 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.
 17.10 Ravine, course S. 75° W.; asc. 160 ft. over broken SW. slope.
 25.40 Spur, slopes N. 70° W.; desc. 180 ft. over N. slope.
 29.65 Ravine, course N. 30° W.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
 30.90 Small spur, slopes N. 85° W.; desc. 230 ft. over N. slope.
 36.65 Intermittent branch, on bare rock bed 20 lks. wide, course S. 75° W.; asc. 100 ft. over SW. slope.
 40.00 Spur, slopes S. 60° W.; desc. 5 ft. along W. slope.
 40.54 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, determined from the original bearing trees, as follows:

A cedar stump, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 60° E., 5 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

A cedar, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 100 lks. dist., with fragments of scribe marks visible on decayed face of partly healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



from which new bearing trees,
