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Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS	
25.40	Dry bed of stream, 2 lks. wide, course S. 30° W.; asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.
29.60	Flat spur, slopes S.; desc. 30 ft. over W. slope.
31.20	Ravine, course S. 10° E.; asc. 47 ft. over E. slope.
33.30	Edge of bench, bears N. and S.; thence over nearly level land.
39.34	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 27, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree, as follows: A fir snag, 60 ins. diam., bears S. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 300 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT on bark blaze. At the corner point Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked $\frac{1}{4} \begin{array}{l} S 22 \\ S 27 \end{array}$ 1953 from which new bearing trees, A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 55° E., 13 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S22 BT. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 80° E., 25 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT. <hr/> N. 89° 42' W., beginning new measurement. Across level bench.
8.00	Leave bench; edge bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.; desc. 100 ft. along broken N. slope.
15.70	Branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 80° W.; thence across bench, along S. edge of old clearing.
30.60	Leave bench, edge bears NW. and SE.; desc. 100 ft. over SW. slope.
33.20	Same branch, 8 lks. wide, course N. 65° W.; asc. 120 ft. over broken NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
39.91	The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28. Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, salmonberry, rhododendron, evergreen and red huckleberry, salal, Oregon grape, and bracken.
	N. 0° 55' E., bet. secs. 21 and 22. Descend 155 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
2.90	Branch, 8 lks. wide, course N. 65° W.; asc. 120 ft. over SW. slope.
7.85	Flat spur, slopes W.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.
9.90	Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° W.; asc. 35 ft. over S. slope.
10.80	Spur, slopes S. 80° W.; desc. 155 ft. over bluff NW. slope.
