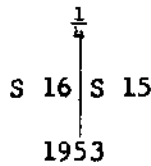


Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



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from which new bearing trees,

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N. 59° E., 40 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 36 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., 26 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S16 BT.

Deposit the remains of the vine maple corner tree alongside the iron post.

North, beginning new measurement.

Ascend 225 ft. over SW. slope, changing to gradual W. slope.

23.65 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope.

26.65 Ravine, course W.; asc. 200 ft. over SW. slope.

36.90 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.

39.00 Head of ravine, course SW.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

40.21 The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16, marked by a fir, 47 ins. diam., marked T20S S10 on NE., R9W S15 on SE., S16 on SW., and S9 on NW. sides, from which

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 71° E., 46 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S10 BT on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree)

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 40° E., 39 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S16 BT on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree)

A fir snag, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 9° W., 29 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree)

An alder stump, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 61° W., 24 lks. dist., with faint scribe marks still visible on decaying blaze. (Mensch bearing tree)

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 20 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S16 BT. (New bearing tree)

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 19° W., 36 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S9 BT on bark blaze. (Thiel bearing tree)

Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmon-berry, evergreen huckleberry, rhododendron, hazel, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14, and 15.

N. 89° 23' W., bet. secs. 10 and 15.

Descend 15 ft. over gradual SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
