

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

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Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 78° E., 65 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R9W S32 BT.

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S. $59\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 63 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R9W S31 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. $42\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 54 lks. dist.,
marked T20S R9W S30 BT.

Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmon-berry, hazel, evergreen huckleberry, arrowwood, salal, and red huckleberry.

From the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33.

N. $86^{\circ} 43'$ W., bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Over roadway.

- 0.35 Edge of access road under construction, bears N. 33° W. and S. 33° E.; desc. 24 ft. over gradual SW. slope of bottom land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 1.80 Right bank of Smith River, course N. 30° W.
- 4.75 Left bank of Smith River; asc. 180 ft. over NE. slope.
- 8.30 Edge of bench, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; along gradual N. slope of bench.
- 11.80 Leave bench; edge bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
- 13.85 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 20° W.; desc. 20 ft. along broken N. slope.
- 19.40 Dry bed of stream, 5 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 135 ft. over NE. slope.
- 33.80 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 15 ft. over NW. slope.
- 35.65 Ravine, course NE.; asc. 15 ft. over E. slope.
- 36.19 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32, at record bearing and distance from each of the original bearing trees, as follows:
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 23° W., 60 lks. dist.,
plainly blazed and healed.
- A maple, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 89° W., 69 lks. dist.,
plainly blazed and healed.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap marked
