

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

An alder, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 32° E., 51 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S32 BT.

N. 89° 34' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 60 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope.

2.80 Ravine, course N. 40° E.; asc. 280 ft. over E. slope.

9.10 Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 130 ft. over W. slope.

12.40 Ravine, course N. 20° W.; asc. 40 ft. over E. slope.

13.90 Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 500 ft. over general W. slope.

41.67 The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, hazel, arrowwood, salal, and bracken.

S. 82° 45' W., bet. secs. 30 and 31.

Descend 58 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.10 Left bank of Smith River, course S.

3.80 Right bank of Smith River; asc. 100 ft. over general E. slope.

6.40 Barbed wire fence, bears N. and S.

6.75 Graded dirt road, bears N. and S.

10.75 Barbed wire fence, bears N. and S.; enter pasture. Top of ascent on rolling bench land; desc. 31 ft. along rolling S. slope of bench.

13.27 Lindstrom's summer cottage, bears S. 25° 31' W.

16.82 Same cottage, bears S. 10° 34' W.

19.27 Barbed wire fence, bears N. and S.; leave pasture; enter heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

21.72 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 15° E., bending to S.; asc. 63 ft. over gentle SE. slope.

22.22 Disused road, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.

26.90 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 21 ft. over SW. slope.

27.62 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 15° E.; asc. 335 ft. over SE. slope.

40.93 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
