CHAINS	<p>A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 17 lks. dist., marked T20S R9W S29 BT.</p> <p>Reset the iron pipe alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmon-berry, hazel, evergreen huckleberry, arrowwood, red huckleberry, bracken, and sword fern.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29.</p> <p>S. $87^{\circ} 46'$ W., bet. secs. 20 and 29.</p> <p>Descend 675 ft. over NW. slope, changing to general W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p> <p>17.80 Johnson Creek, 30 lks. wide, course S. 20° E., on bend to SW.; asc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.</p> <p>22.00 Spur, slopes S. 85° E.; asc. 63 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope, near back of spur.</p> <p>23.47 Graded trail, bears N. 10° E. and S. 20° W., at point 10 lks.
