1.81	<p>Descend 40 ft. over SW. slope.</p> <p>The <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of sec. 8 only, monumented by Fred Mensch, in 1921, with an iron post, 1 in. diam., 9 ins. above ground, firmly set, but badly rusted, with brass cap marked</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 8 1921</p> <p>At the corner point, in place of the rusted iron post.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 8 1954</p> <p>from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. <math>32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}</math> E., 33 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed. (Old bearing tree; record, bears N. <math>30^{\circ}</math> E., 35 lks. dist.)</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. <math>63\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}</math> W., 140 lks. dist., marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S8 BT. (New bearing tree.)</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A cascara, 10 ins. diam., bears N. <math>63^{\circ}</math> W., 34 lks. dist., with no marks remaining. (Old bearing tree.)</p> <p>Deposit the old iron post at the base of the new one.</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: 10px auto;"/>
9.20	<p>N. <math>89^{\circ} 28'</math> W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Descend 320 ft. over W. slope.</p>
26.45	<p>Branch, 5 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 600 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope.</p>
26.45	<p>Spur ridge, bears N. <math>5^{\circ}</math> E. and S. <math>5^{\circ}</math> W.; desc. 400 ft. over broken W. slope, changing to NW. slope.</p>
36.79	<p>The cor. of secs. 17 and 18, on the S. bdy. of sec. 8.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, yew, dogwood, and cascara. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, rhododendron, hazel, evergreen and red huckleberry, arrowwood, thimbleberry, and salal.</p> <hr/>
2.41	<p>N. <math>89^{\circ} 35'</math> W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 18.</p> <p>Descend 34 ft. along N. slope, changing to NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 7 and 8, on the N. bdy. of sec. 18, monumented by Fred Mensch, in 1921, with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.</p> <hr/>
8.40	<p>N. <math>89^{\circ} 35'</math> W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Descend 185 ft. over NW. slope.</p> <p>Wet ravine, course W., from N. <math>80^{\circ}</math> E.; desc. 5 ft. along ravine.</p>
