CHAINS	
	Descend slightly along E. slope; through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
1.84	A hemlock, 25 ins. diam., on line, marked with two notches each on N. and S. sides.
3.76	Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 30 ft. over broken SE. slope.
7.40	Branch, 6 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
9.75	Branch, 4 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 343 ft. over gradual SE. slope.

13.20	A maintained trail, bears NE. and SW.; continue ascent.
22.60	Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 172 ft. over steep N. slope.
28.40	Ravine, course NW.; asc. 24 ft. over SW. slope.
33.70	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 169 ft. over steep N. slope.
