

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

## CHAINS

- 34.60 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 199 ft. over steep SW. slope.
- 41.60 Paradise Creek, 40 lks. wide, flowing on bedrock, bears S. 30° W.; thence across bottom.
- 41.93 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 12 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in a drill hole in sandstone bedrock, swelled into hole by a metal wedge in the split lower end, with brass cap marked

- from which
- A white fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 64° E., 74 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S36 BT.
- A fir, 57 ins. diam., bears N. 66° W., 52 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S25 BT.
- Ascend slightly over bottom.
- 42.10 Unimproved road, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.; asc. 214 ft. over SE. slope.
- 46.90 Spur, slopes S. 15° E.; desc. 18 ft. over SW. slope.
- 49.60 Ravine, general course S. 20° E.; asc. 236 ft. over SE. slope.
- 54.80 Spur, slopes SE.; asc. 73 ft. along S. slope.
- 58.50 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 243 ft. over SW. slope.
- 65.60 A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 434 ft. over steep NE. slope.
- 75.00 Spur, slopes S. 35° E.; desc. 37 ft. along S. slope.
- 83.86 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.
- Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay and sandstone. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin, and madrona. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salal, ceanothus, manzanita, bracken, and poison oak.
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- N. 1° 17' E., bet. secs. 25 and 26.
- Ascend 230 ft. over S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 9.00 Spur, slopes SE.; asc. 35 ft. over SE. slope.
- 14.00 Top of ascent, slopes E.; desc. 63 ft. along E. slope.
- 21.85 Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 118 ft. over S. slope.
- 26.65 Tractor trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 27.30 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 104 ft. over steep NW. slope.
- 31.30 Head of ravine, drains W.; asc. 21 ft. over SW. slope.
