Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

from which new bearing trees,

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 44° E., 64 lks. dist.,
marked T21S R8W S1 BT.

A hemlock, 23 ins. diam., bears S. $8\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 36 lks. dist.,
marked T21S R8W S12 BT.

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S. $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 16 lks. dist.,
marked T21S R8W S11 BT.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 7° W.; 8 lks. dist.,
marked T21S R8W S2 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood, and yew. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, ceanothus, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described.

N. $89^{\circ} 23'$ W., bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Descend 28 ft. along steep N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.60 Small spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.

4.00 Ravine, course N.; asc. 123 ft. over NE. slope.

7.30 Spur, slopes N. 10° W.; desc. 162 ft. over NW. slope.

10.90 Ravine, course N.; asc. 56 ft. along broken N. slope.

12.25 Small spur, slopes N. 10° E.; desc. 14 ft. along broken N. slope.

13.95 Ravine, course N. 20° E.; asc. 203 ft. over NE. slope.

18.95 Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 159 ft. over NW. slope.

23.00 Head of ravine, course N. 30° W.; asc. 13 ft. along N. slope.

25.90 Spur, slopes N. 50° W.; desc. 261 ft. over W. slope.

31.50 Head of ravine, course N. 30° W.; desc. 16 ft. along N. slope.

35.10 Spur, slopes N. 30° W.; desc. 209 ft. over W. slope.

40.46 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 47° W., 30 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S1 BT.

A fir, 75 ins. diam., bears S. 14° E., 24 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S12 BT.

Descend 19 ft. over W. slope.

41.50 Dirt road, on curve from W. to N.; thence near N. edge of road.
