Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

42.15	Halfway Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 10° E.; asc. 9 ft. across narrow creek bottom.
43.50	Road curves to S. from E.
43.60	Branch, 2 lks. wide, rerouted during road construction, drains N.; asc. 61 ft. over general SE. slope.
51.20	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 75° E.; asc. 529 ft. over general E. slope.
77.70	Spur ridge, bears N. 10° E. and S. 30° W.; desc. 102 ft. over NW. slope.
80.92	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, madrona, yew, and dogwood; some selective logging of better firs has been carried on to N. of line in E. one-quarter mile, about 40 years ago. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, hazel, arrowwood, ceanothus, salal, poison oak, and fern.
	N. 4° 40' E., bet. secs. 1 and 2.
	Descend 290 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
8.70	Spur, slopes steeply NW.; desc. 247 ft. over precipitous N. slope.
13.90	Left bank of Smith River, course S. 80° W., bending to W.
14.90	Right bank of Smith River; asc. 420 ft. over S. slope, changing to SE. slope.
16.60	Gravelled road, bears N. 60° E. and S. 85° W.
36.50	Spur, slopes S. 60° E.; asc. 27 ft. along E. slope.
39.30	Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 32 ft. over NE. slope.
40.01	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

	Descend 135 ft. over NE. slope.
42.90	Head of ravine, course N. 70° E.; asc. 95 ft. over SE. slope.
47.10	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 95 ft. over broken NE. slope.
