16.60	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 312 ft. over steep SW. slope.
26.40	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 337 ft. over steep NW. slope.
33.40	Branch, 4 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 61 ft. over SE. slope.
35.00	Spur, slopes S.; desc. 20 ft. along S. slope.
38.65	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked <div style="text-align: center;">$\frac{1}{4} \frac{S \ 27}{S \ 34}$ 1952</div> from which A fir, 56 ins. diam., bears N. 65° 45' E., 307 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT. A fir, 62 ins. diam., bears S. 54 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 410 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT. Descend slightly along S. slope.
40.80	A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.; asc. 93 ft. over SE. slope.
47.30	Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 176 ft. over SW. slope.
54.80	Branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 237 ft. along steep, broken N. slope.
63.50	Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 38 ft. along broken N. slope.
70.70	Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 104 ft. along N. slope.
77.30	The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, marked with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay and sandstone. Timber, recently burned over fir, hemlock, and cedar. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, bracken, and poison oak.
