

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 9.20 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 144 ft. over NW. slope.
 12.60 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 150 ft. over NE. slope.
 16.20 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 79 ft. over NW. slope.
 18.70 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 259 ft. along broken N. slope.
 26.40 Ridge and tractor trail, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; desc. 394 ft. over steep W. slope.

37.78 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 26, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

$$\frac{1}{4} \frac{S \ 23}{S \ 26}$$

A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N. $84\frac{1}{4}^\circ$ W., 27 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S23 BT.

A fir, 65 ins. diam., bears S. 12° 45' W., 130 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT.

Descend 25 ft. over W. slope.

- 38.30 Ravine, drains SW.; asc. 24 ft. over NE. slope.
 39.50 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 34 ft. over SW. slope.
 41.50 Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 551 ft. over steep E. slope.
 57.20 Spur, slopes S. 10° E.; desc. 206 ft. over steep SW. slope.
 61.60 Ravine, drains SW.; desc. 162 ft. over SW. slope.
 73.50 Ravine, drains S.; asc. 105 ft. over steep E. slope.
 75.56 The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay and sandstone. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and madrona. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, huckleberry, salal, ceanothus, bracken, and poison oak.

S. 87° 25' W., bet. secs. 22 and 27.

Ascend 40 ft. over rocky E. slope, through heavy timber and burned undergrowth.

 3.80 Ravine, drains S. 30° E.; asc. 350 ft. over SE. slope.
 13.70 Ridge, divide between Paradise Creek and Smith River, bears N. 13° E. and S. 43° W.; desc. 202 ft. over NW. slope.
 19.50 Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 16 ft. over broken NW. slope.
 20.60 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 110 ft. over NW. slope.
 24.70 Ravine, drains N. 20° E.; asc. 166 ft. over broken NW. slope.
