

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS	
28.60	Spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 271 ft. over NW. slope.
35.50	Ravine, drains N. 10° W.; asc. 119 ft. over NE. slope.
37.92	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 27, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap marked  $\frac{1}{4} \begin{array}{l} S 22 \\ S 27 \end{array}$ 1952  from which  A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 11° W., 17 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S22 BT.  A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 5° W., 35 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT.  Descend 132 ft. over steep NW. slope.
40.60	Ravine, drains N. 10° E.; asc. 309 ft. over E. slope.
49.30	Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 515 ft. over rocky SW. slope, over recently burned area.
62.40	Deep ravine, drains NW.; asc. 97 ft. over NE. slope.
64.65	Spur, slopes NE ; desc. 25 ft. over NW. slope.
65.80	Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 292 ft. over E. slope.
73.00	Spur, slopes NE.; asc. 59 ft. over NE. slope.
74.50	Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 49 ft. over steep NW. slope.
75.84	The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, marked with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.  Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, and madrona. Undergrowth, almost entirely consumed by recent fire; with various kinds of brush sprouting up from burned crowns, poison oak and ferns being predominate at this time.
	From the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27.  N. 0° 27' E., bet. secs. 22 and 23.  Descend 40 ft. along steep E. slope, through scattering timber and light undergrowth, partly burned.
2.10	Ravine, course S. 80° E.; asc. 290 ft. over S. slope.
8.00	Ridge, the divide bet. Umpqua River and Smith River, bears E. and W.; enter heavily burned area beginning to grow up to low brush; desc. 260 ft. over N. slope.
16.35	Head of ravine, course N. 30° E.; asc. 10 ft. along E. slope.
22.35	Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 400 ft. over N. slope.
