

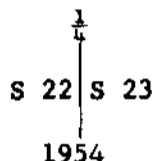
Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

31.15 Intermittent branch, 5 lks. wide, course N. 70° W.; asc. 50 ft. over broken SW. slope.

36.87 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

An iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears East, 60 lks. dist., with brass cap marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S23 RM 1954 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears West, 60 lks. dist., with brass cap marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S22 RM 1954 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

Ascend 360 ft. over SW. slope.

53.45 Spur, slopes N. 75° W.; desc. 360 ft. over N. slope, changing to NE. slope.

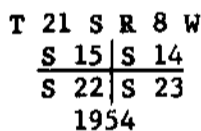
59.95 Ravine, course N. 30° W.; desc. 40 ft. along W. slope.

64.25 Spur, slopes N. 40° W.; desc. 125 ft. over N. slope.

66.60 Intermittent branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 75° W.; asc. 110 ft. over S. slope.

73.74 Point for the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

An iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 45° E., 50 lks. dist., with brass cap marked T21S R8W S14 RM 1954 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 45° W., 50 lks. dist., with brass cap marked T21S R8W S22 RM 1954 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

Land, mountainous. Soil, fine sandy shale overlying sandstone. Timber, scattering fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder S. of divide; almost entirely consumed by fire N. of divide. Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salal, Oregon grape, and huckleberry.
